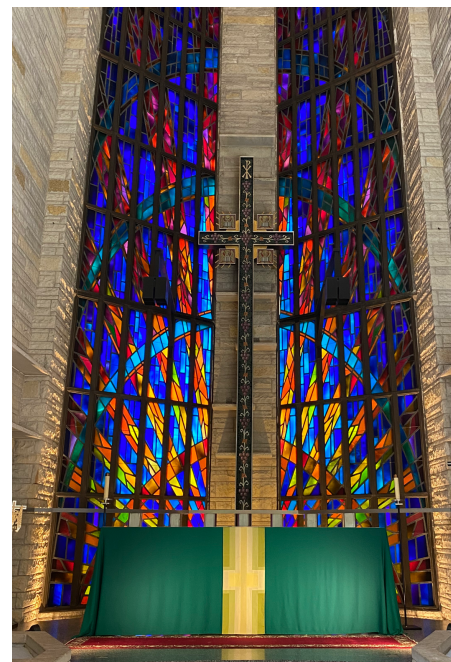
BACK TO CHURCH

GREAT NEWS – On **Sunday, July 5th**, at 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. we will be back in the Sanctuary of the church! There are a number of changes to note when we return to church in order to provide for your safety and the safety of all of us:

Out of an abundance of caution everyone is required to wear a mask in the church and during the service.

Everyone must sign in and have their temperature taken, which will not be recorded.

There will be no singing by the congregation and responses and prayers should be spoken quietly.



Sharing of the Peace will be done in place and without contact. A nod toward the neighbor, a bow of the head, a wave or other signs of mutual spiritual respect can be used.

Following the service an usher will dismiss you from your seat. Please exit immediately. Pastor will greet people in the courtyard, weather permitting.

If you are uncomfortable resuming in-person worship you can watch the 10:30 a.m. Service on the web site. There will also be a weekly Wednesday spoken eucharist from 12:15 to 12:45 p.m. beginning Wednesday, July 8 in the rear of the Sanctuary by the Baptismal Font.
